It is not possible to have a dynamic, successful youth program without you! **Stop at the volunteer table to see how your spiritual gifts can help our youth.**

Connect (MS or HS Sunday School) Sept. thru May

Connect Sunday School seeks to bring the Word of God to youth through a variety of activities appealing to different learning styles. We are looking for individuals who will teach once a month. We are also looking for assistants who will help lead small group discussion, supervise games and other activities.

Confirmation Guide September thru April, Wednesday Nights, 6:30-8:15

Guides are small group leaders for our confirmation program. As a guide, your job is to build relationships with the youth and help them build relationships with each other. You DO NOT need to be a theologian

Hospitality Guru

Provide food and hospitality for our youth. We want our church to be a place your youth want to come to. If you like to cook, provide goodies or are just good at welcoming, this is the job for you!
